



q3 How much do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements? (%)


> Since the war in Ukraine started, the EU has been united in responding to the war

Since the war started, the EU has shown solidarity




q4 For each of the following measures that have been announced by the EU to respond to the war in Ukraine, please tell me if you approve them or not. (%)






The EU should reduce its dependency on Russian gas and oil as soon as possible




The war in Ukraine makes it more urgent for EU Member States to invest in renewable energy




The EU should take measures to increase energy efficiency of buildings, transport, and goods
